Prefects' Badge in 1917

In 1917 the Prefects had a special badge they wore on the left-hand side of their white blouses. The girls wore long dark skirts because the Black Watch tartan did not become part of the uniform until 1918.

The photograph of the Prefects in the December 1917 issue of the *Aurora* shows the Prefects' badge. The Archives is fortunate to have two examples of this early badge.
